Currently, as Managing Partner of Magellan Infrastructure Partners, he oversees projects that finance sustainable infrastructure focused on green energy and resource preservation. Djebbari also serves on boards in the aerospace industry and advises companies on industrialization and global expansion strategies.

A graduate of Ecole Nationale de l'Aviation Civile and Ecole Polytechnique, Djebbari's extensive training and experience are reflected in his hands-on expertise in both technical and policy-driven aspects of transportation and energy.
